General Guidelines for the Artist Alley

- Here Comes Summer is a non-profit event
- Liability Insurance has been secured
- Promotional Materials will be provided (date of availability T. B. A.)
- Set up and dismantle (T. B. A.)
- Security has been secured

General Application requirements

Only one person per application form. All applications must include:

- A signed completed application. Save a copy for your records.
- A detailed physical description of the artist wears to be displayed and sold.
- Application fee: \$100.00, The application fee must be in Canadian funds and is non refundable. (with the one exception that the event is cancelled due to a perceived regional health emergency).

Application Deadline

The BIA must receive your application no later than June 1st at 5pm in order to make the Here Comes Summer Directory listing. June 15th at 5pm is set as our final application acceptance date for the Artist Alley. (Note: Limited space available, all applications will be accepted on a first come first served basis.)

There is an Artist Alley drop off box located at the Liberty Village BIA office for those of you who wish to hand deliver your application and money. For those of you who cannot make the trip into the office, please mail your application form and fee to the BIA office listed below.

We will e-mail or call confirmation of receipt of applications and further details with regard to set up and break down times.
